- Starting with loans originated in 2025, you may be able to deduct up to \$10,000/yr in auto loan interest — but only for new, U.S.-assembled, personal-use vehicles.

- The benefit is temporary (2025-2028) and phases out for higher income taxpayers.

- You don't need to itemize to take advantage of it (since it's above-the-line).

- To claim it, make sure to keep documentation: Interest will be reported on your December 2025 NMFCU statement.
